Acceptable Donations

- **Furniture (no tears, stains, pet hair, must be clean and structurally intact)**
 - Couches, chairs, & love seats
 - Recliners & rockers
 - Coffee & end tables
 - Dining tables & chairs
 - Dressers, bed frames, & nightstands
 - Bookshelves & desks
 - Antiques & collectables
- **Appliances (less than 10-years old, clean, and in working order)**
 - Refrigerators & freezers
 - Ranges with ovens
 - Washers/dryers
 - Dishwashers
 - Microwaves
 - Small appliances (toasters, blenders, coffee makers, etc.)
 - TV's (5-years old or less)
- **Home Décor**
 - Art, décor, paintings, photographs, picture frames, etc.
- **Household Goods**
 - Dinnerware, silverware, pots & pans, utensils, glassware
- **Building Materials (new or in good condition, with no nails or screws)**
 - Lumber – 3' long or more
 - Wood trim – 3' long or more
 - Plywood, OSB, or wainscoting – ¼+ sheet
 - Siding & roofing materials
 - Decking & fencing
 - Flooring (tile, hardwood, laminate; box units only)
 - Shelving
 - Hardware - like new or new (no rust)



Acceptable Donations Cont.

- **Building Materials Continued**
 - Doors - interior, exterior, storm
 - Windows
 - Hand & power tools
- **Cabinets and Countertops (complete units and structurally intact)**
- **Plumbing (clean and in good condition)**
 - Kitchen, bath, utility sinks
 - Toilets
 - Faucets, showerheads, hardware
- **Lamps (must be working, with all parts)**
- **Lawn & Garden (in working condition with all parts)**
 - Tools, lawnmowers, weed trimmers, etc.
 - Flowerpots, yard décor
 - Fencing, rain gutter, snow fence
- **Rugs (must be new or in excellent condition)**
 - Area rugs, carpet, throw rugs
- **Paint (new)**
- **Clothing and Shoes**
 - Washed, dried, folded or on hangers
 - Only 1 bag/container per donor per visit

Why Donate to the ReStore?

Your donation does more than clear space at home. It creates local impact.

Items Not Accepted



- Mattresses & box springs
- Items intended for use by children under the age of 12
 - Cribs, bassinets/cradles, safety gates or enclosures, play pens infant swings, highchairs, toddler beds, strollers, toy chests, helmets, bean bag chairs
- Items containing lead-based paint
 - Toys, costume jewelry, furniture
- Cleaning chemicals, pesticides, insecticides, herbicides, fungicides
- Unlabeled containers of liquid
- Used hot water heaters, disposals, pipes
- Industrial vents
- Toilets
- Exercise equipment
- Fire rated doors (may contain asbestos)
- Corded window blinds
- Unframed glass (unframed mirrors, tabletops, unframed windows, picture frames, etc.)
- Shower doors
- Pianos & organs
- Used bedding
- Technology
 - Laptops, desktops, hard drives
- Bootleg and homemade media (CD's, DVD's, VHS)
- Alcohol
- Weapons, firearms, and/or powder-actuated items, including fireworks
- Used car parts
- Rolled flashing
- Used helmets/hard hats
- Offensive or racially inappropriate items
- Expired materials
- Vehicles/trailers (Ask about our "Cars for Homes" program!)
- Gas appliances/gas lines (furnaces, heaters, used gas lines, water heaters)
- Used paint
 - Oil-based paint, paints containing lead, paint cans that are not full
- Used fire alarms/fire suppression systems
 - Smoke alarms, carbon monoxide detectors, fire extinguishers
- Used safety equipment
- Used ladders
- Used medical equipment
- Flammable gasses
- Household chemicals
- Broken/faulty electronics or power tools (missing guards, frayed cords, missing safety feature)
